

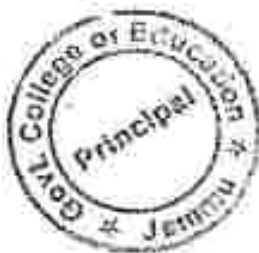

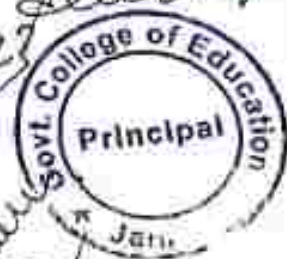

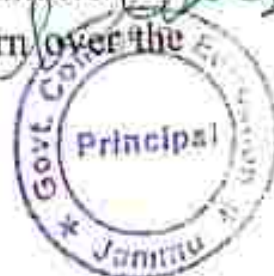


Earth Day CELEBRATION (22-04-2018)

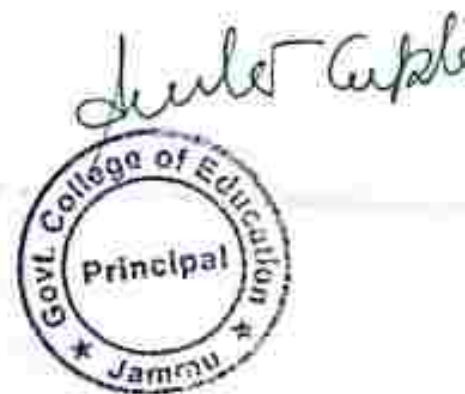


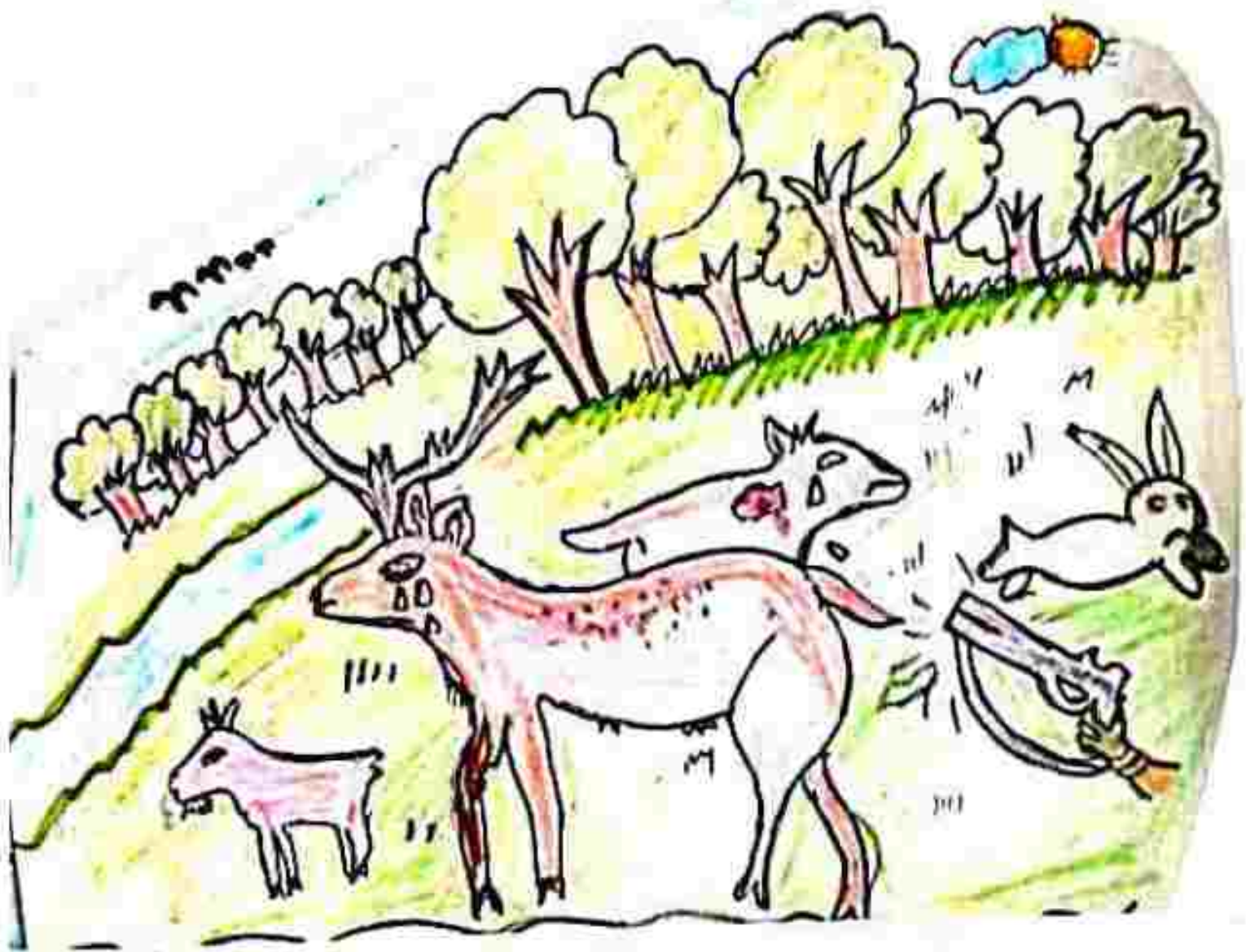


GCOE Organized Slogan Writing Competition on World Conservation Day

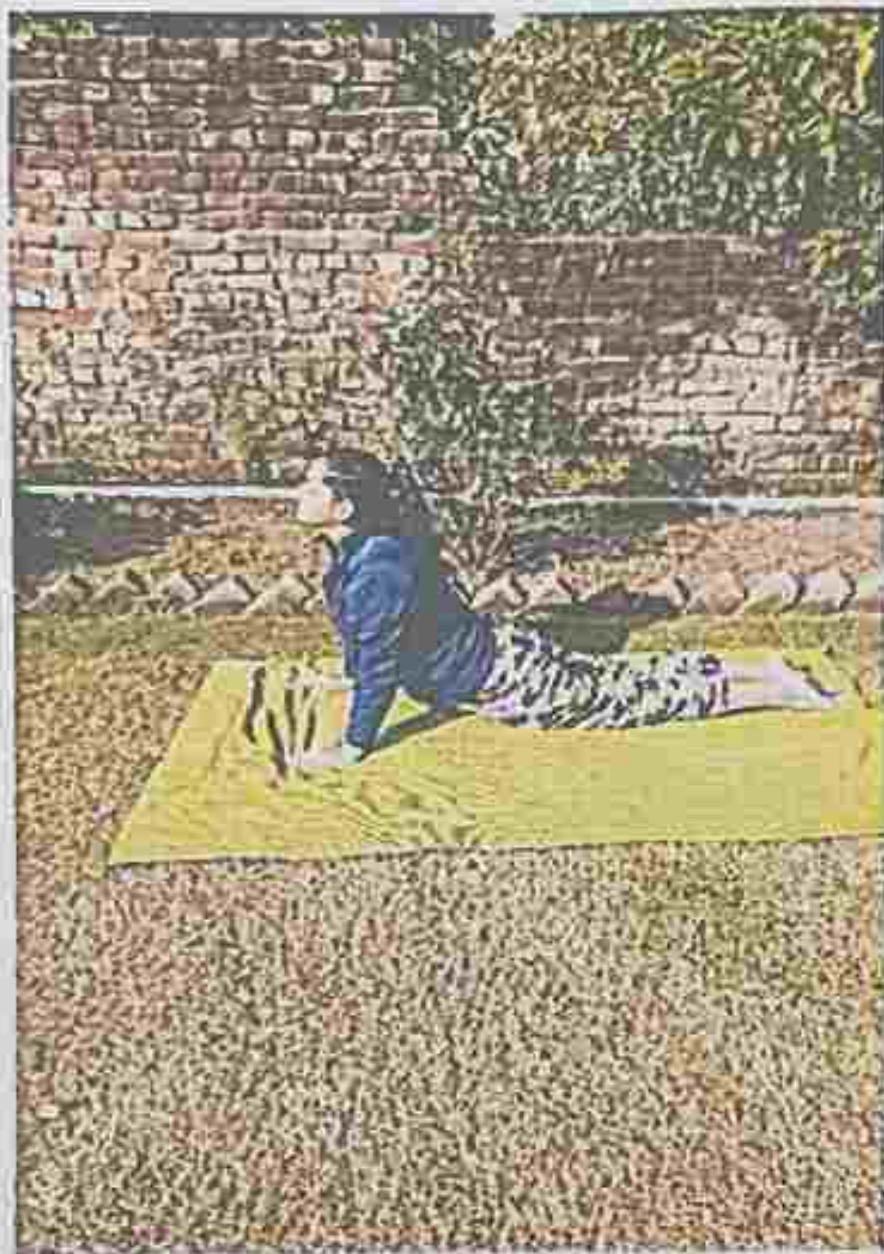
Report on National Youth Day:

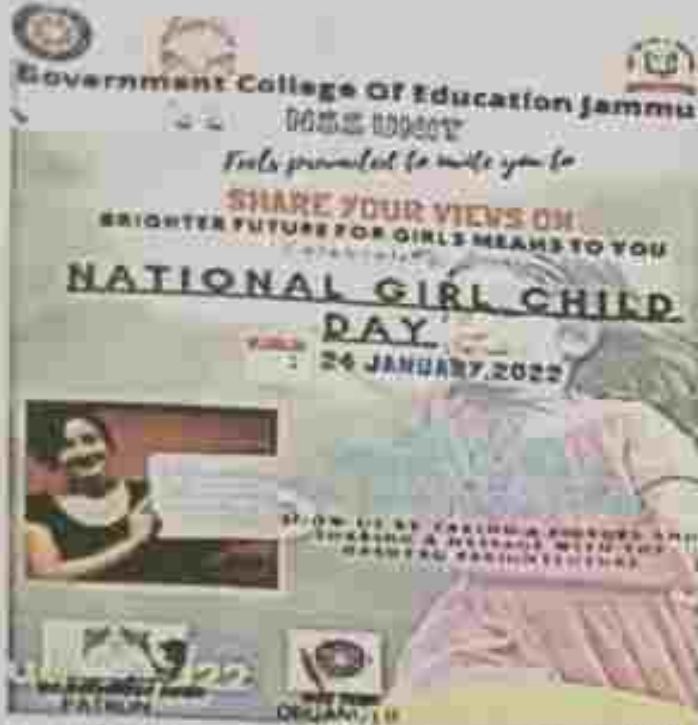

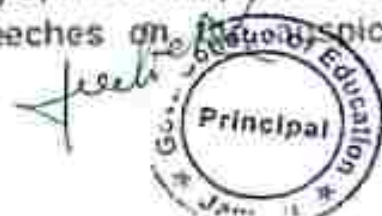

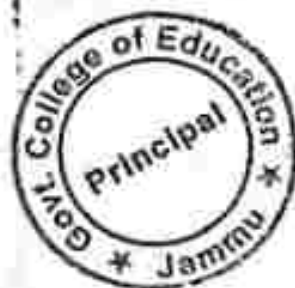
